

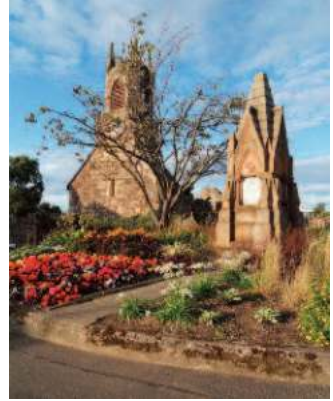
Return to the Cradle of Irish Presbyterianism, 16-21 Sep 2013
