

Carey

One particular gravestone records the death of ⁴Julia Carey (nee Pasche) who died 5 days after giving birth to ⁵Henry Pasche Carey and ¹³Julia Pasche Carey. They were born on the 4th May 1865 and Henry died on June 5th 1865, aged 1 month.

⁴Julia Carey [Pasche] fell asleep in Jesus May 9th 1865 aged 36 years and 9 months.

⁵Henry Pasche Carey, born May 4th 1865, departed June 5th 1865.

⁶Joseph William Carey, Presbyter of the Unitas Fratrum, departed Decr 23rd 1876 aged 49.

In memory of ⁷Sarah Anne Carey, born 6th March 1830, died 21st May 1882.

In memory of ⁸Catherine Maria Pasche, Died 30th July 1919 aged 86 years.

Also included in the same grave is Julia's Husband, the Reverend ⁶Joseph William Carey, he is referred to as "Presbyter of the Unitas Fatrum" or Minister of the United Brethren (Moravian). Born in Dublin January 31st 1826 to the Rev John Carey and Jane Keary. He was educated at Horton and Gracehill, and was Minister at the Bristol, Ayr, Kilwarlin (approximately 1864-1873) and Kilkeel churches. He died in Belfast on December 23rd 1876.

There is an entry in the church minutes of the families' arrival at Kilwarlin on the 27th July 1864. ⁶Joseph William and ⁴Julia Carey and four children, ⁹Joseph, ¹⁰John, ¹¹Maria and ¹²Jane. The most notable of these children was ⁹Joseph William Carey Junior (1859-1937) who was later to become a famous painter and illustrator. His most important work as an artist was 13 scenes from Belfast history on Canvas for the Ulster Hall in 1903 (restored in 1989). Ulster History Circle (2002).

The coloured numbers correspond to an individual recorded in the inscriptions, baptisms, marriage and burial records etc.

On the 4th May 1865, in the Baptismal register of the church, the births of ⁵Henry Pasche Carey and ¹³Julia Pasche Carey are recorded, witnesses are John Carey, ⁶J W Carey, ⁷Sarah Anne Carey and ⁸Catherine M Pasche. ⁸Catherine is also recorded as a witness at the wedding of William Henry Gordan to Sarah Anna Abernety on July 30th 1871 in Kilwarlin.

The marriage of ⁶Joseph William Carey to ⁴Julia Pasche took place in Castletown, Malew, Isle of Man on the 9th May 1855, which by coincidence was also the date she was to die 10 years later.

The Careys' first child, John was born on the 18th August 1857 but must have died, because three years later they are recorded as having another child whom they also named ¹⁰John, on the 6th February 1860. ⁹Joseph Jnr was born on January 12th 1859, ¹¹Maria on March 3rd 1862 and ¹²Jane on the 8th November 1863. All these baptisms were recorded in Ayr, Scotland.

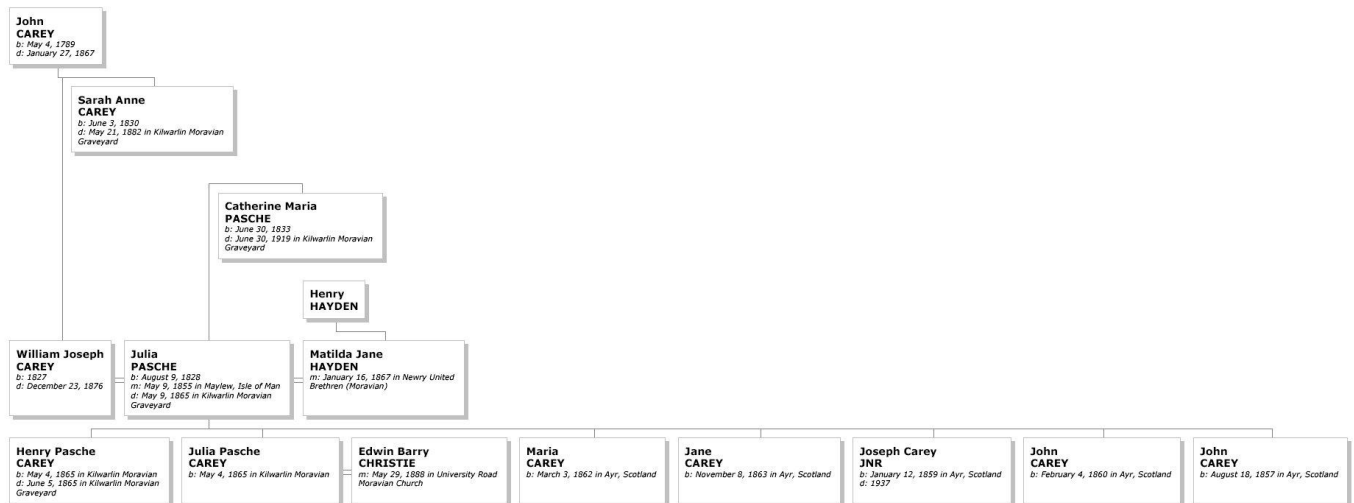
After the death of his wife, ⁶Joseph Carey remarried Matilda Jane Hayden, in Newry United Brethren on January 16th 1867. His father is recorded as John Carey with the Minister also recorded as the Rev J Carey.

There is an inscription for John Carey, in Gracehill Moravian Church it reads:

*Here lie the remains of John Carey a poor sinner saved by grace,
He believed in the Lord Jesus Christ and his precious atonement for the pardon of sin,
Peace with God and life everlasting,
therefore in the blessed hope of a glorious resurrection to bliss unspeakable,
he rest in peace,
born May 4th 1789,
fell asleep in Jesus January 27th 1867, aged 77 years 9 months.*

¹³Julia Pasche Carey married Edwin Barry Christie, at University Road Moravian on May 28th 1888. His occupation is recorded as Clergyman, more than likely he was a Moravian Minister. Her sister ¹¹Maria was a witness.

Blandford – An extremely rare English surname.

In loving memory of Eliza Blandford, widow of the late Rev. H. E. Blandford, Bishop of the Moravian Church, who fell asleep July 10th 1914 aged 60 years.

Blythe - Unusual surname, found in the householders index; Belfast (1), Antrim (2), Down (6), Tyrone (7), Monaghan (1) and Offaly (1). The midlands surname is from Irish origin; otherwise it is of English origin.

John Walker a Farmer from Corcreeny and Margaret McLeavy also from Corcreeny, married in St John's Church of Ireland, Kilwarlin on the 9th June 1864. Father's are Thomas Walker a farmer and ³³John McLeavy. Witnesses are ³³John McLeavy and Thomas Scandrett, marriage performed by Rev H B St George.

John McKitrick a Book Keeper from 22 Lonsdale Street, Belfast, to Anna Julia McLeavy from Corcreeny on 18th February 1870 in Kilwarlin Moravian Church. Fathers are Alexander McKitrick a farmer and ³³John McLeavy also a Farmer. Witnesses are John McKitrick and Jessie Brown, married by Rev J W Carey.

The † infant daughter of ³⁶George and ³⁷Susan Moxon, born 18th April 1855.

No record of this is recorded in the baptism or burial register of the church. ³⁶George Moxon was the Minister of Kilwarlin between the years 1852-1855 and they are recorded in the baptismal register of the church as having a child by the name of Harriet Susan daughter of ³⁶George and ³⁷Susan Moxon, 28th December 1852.

Scandrett - Recorded in the householders index as a rare surname, only found in Belfast (2), Antrim (1) and Down (7).

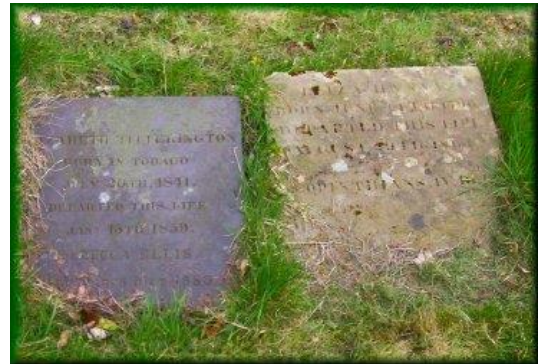
