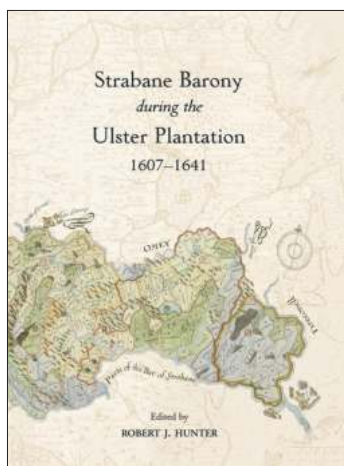


The R.J. Hunter Collection

The Ulster Plantation of the early 17th century was a period of critical importance in the shaping of modern Ulster. However, there have been relatively few studies that have looked in detail at the impact of the Plantation scheme at the local level. Forty years ago a small group, under the leadership of the late Robert J. Hunter, looked firstly at the Plantation of Ulster and then sought out information for this period relating specifically to the barony of Strabane. Chapters in this book look at Strabane in the pre-Plantation era, the background of the Scottish undertakers, the development of the town of Strabane, and the socio-economic conditions prevailing in the early seventeenth century. First published over 30 years ago, this fresh edition presents to a new audience the story of the Plantation in Strabane. It stands as an exemplar of the way in which a professional historian and his students can successfully work together to produce a high-quality publication.

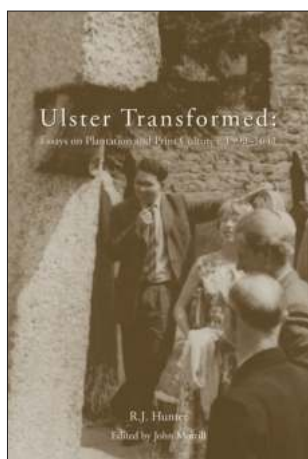
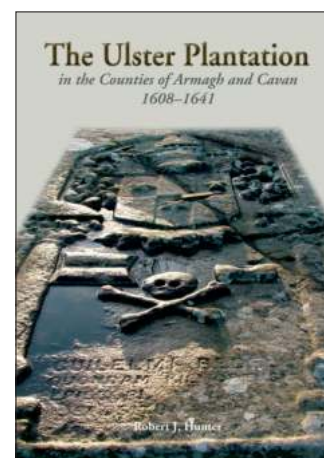
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
